### SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE METVET PROJECT

METVET – Joint Higher VET Course in the Metal Sector is a European project under the Erasmus + Key Action 3 – Support for Policy Reform, Joint Qualifications in Vocational Education and Training. The project co-funded by the ERASMUS + programme and it was developed with a partnership which involved vocational training institutions and organisations dealing with VET from Greece, Italy, Germany and Belgium.

METVET aimed at creating a European offer of adapted and innovative initial training and certification on EQF level 5, concerning skills' developments (fabrication and installation of aluminium frames) for Aluminium & Metal Constructions technicians, as much as international standards, regulations and certification awareness, based on common transnational curricula.

Experts from the partner organisations, following their active involvement and discussions with national and European stakeholders joined forces to create the following outcomes:

- a professional (qualification) profile & a core curriculum (EQF 5);
- a corresponding VET program, including innovative teaching methods; and
- a qualification standard (according to ISO/IEC17024) for evaluation & certification.

All the above were achieved through the strengthening of the exchange of knowledge and practice between education and training institutions and the labor market.

The METVET project started in September 2018 but has now successfully reached its funding period closure. All METVET outcomes and activities will remain available on the [project website](http://www.metvet.eu) and the all the project partners have pledged to continue supporting and promoting the METVET course through as signatory parts of a Memorandum of Understanding.
